- Writing/editing <u>press releases</u>, <u>media advisories</u>, <u>news briefs</u>, <u>blogs</u>, <u>Tweets</u>, <u>Facebook</u> posts, and informational blurbs for DOL's <u>weekly online national newsletter</u>
- Writing feature stories and photo cutlines for DOL internal website *LaborNet* and internal, monthly emagazine *Frances Magazine*
- Creating photo/ video content for internal and external publics
- Conducting research to further develop internal media relations database and enhance regional media relations outreach efforts
- Performing light administrative work

REQUIREMENTS:

- Excellent written and verbal communication skills, experience (preferred) using AP Stylebook guidelines, good computer skills, and a professional and positive attitude
- > Experience with public relations and social media measurement tools and thorough knowledge of social media platforms
- > Students must be able to meet the minimum time commitment, 8-10 hours/week
- > Bilingual students are encouraged to apply
